


<u>Virginia is one of 22 States and territories</u> that operates its own OSH program:


- ❖ Jurisdiction: Private Employers (GI, Const & AG) & state and local government workers (including Maritime).

- Private Sector Consultation funded 90% by OSHA
















Data shows that over98% of all accidents are preventable.







Fatalities CY21









